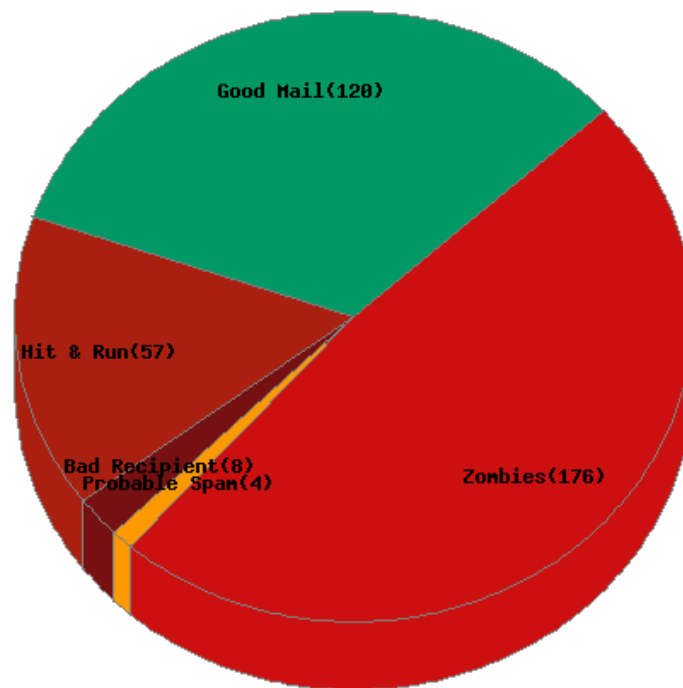


Sample Daily Report

The xspaminate system provides daily updates for the IT Manager detailing email traffic for the previous day. The system is designed to be as autonomous as possible minimising management of the system, so the daily report is designed to give rapid overview of key information. This also ensures any issues can be quickly and simply identified.

Summary

The first part of the report shows the level of activity. In this example a high proportion of email is not spam – around 90% SPAM is normal - but the user can see that 8 emails were sent to “bad recipients”. These user mailboxes that do not exist on the xspaminate account. In case these are valid accounts that the administrator has forgotten to add the report shows the mailboxes, see below:

Bad Recipient Details

The IT Manager can now log into the portal and immediately add 'user@domain.co.uk' if it is a valid mailbox or alternatively ignore it if the mailbox no longer exists.

The report also details 'Probable Spam'. The idea of probable spam is to let the recipient know that an email looks like spam but the system is not sure enough to make a decision. In this scenario an email is sent to the recipient from xspaminate with the 'probable spam' email attached. Any emails that are flagged as probable spam are logged in the daily report so the IT Manager can view trends and if necessary adjust the score value at which emails are dropped. The xspaminate portal also allows users to define whitelists or blacklist repeat offenders.

So in this instance the domain *@aria.co.uk could be blacklisted to prevent further offers being sent through and joe@domains.co.uk whitelisted if that is a valid or wanted sender.
